Homework: The homework in this course will consist of creating and practicing flashcards from the vocabulary and the grammar, and completing exercises from the workbook and text. It will be graded by me as a completion grade only, because we have so many tests and quizzes that I will grade for correctness. Because we have so little class time, the parents' participation is vital. Parents will initial the weekly HW assignment page next to the appropriate day to prove completion. And then this page will be turned in to me for grading. (Besides the first quarter.)

Late Work: Late work will be deducted by $20 \%$ if it is late. If it is not turned when I collect it,
then it is considered late.
Participation: It is required that students participate in class activities and discussion. To do so, students must study, and complete all assigned coursework to maintain on track with the class. Again, studying is required! For most students, study time for this class will exceed many other classes.
